REGULATIONS FOR SHEEP CLASSES

1. All animals must be identified with an approved CCIA or NLID ear tag.
2. All breeds show together.
3. Sheep must be on the fairgrounds by 11am.
4. Exhibitors 18 yrs. & over must be members of the society (entry fee \$3.00)
5. Livestock exhibitors must carry a minimum of one million dollars liability insurance and may be asked for proof of insurance upon registration.
6. All other general rules & regulations of the society apply.
7. Any type of abuse of animals at the show will not be tolerated and the exhibitor will be asked to leave by the Listowel Agricultural Society.
8. Exhibitors are responsible for removal of manure and bedding to a designated area. All garbage is to be removed from bedding.
9. Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Sheep must be followed, including guidelines for tail docking. Failure to follow the code of practice may result in an exhibitor being asked to leave the show.
