- 3. Leadline competitors may not compete in any other class.
- 4. Gaming entries that have not entered the ring after the third and final call to run will be automatically disqualified.
- 5. Youth barrels is not a leadline class and the rider is to be unassisted after crossing the starting line.
- 6. MWHA rules apply.
- 7. All youth participating in timed events (games) are required to wear a helmet. Leadliners are required to wear a helmet. Youth competing in performance events are not required to wear a helmet but please feel free to do so. The choice is yours to make.
- 8. Livestock exhibitors must carry a minimum of one million dollars liability insurance and may be asked for proof of insurance upon registration.
- 9. Any type of abuse of animals at the show will not be tolerated and the exhibitor will be asked to leave by the Listowel Agricultural Society.
- 10. Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Equines must be followed. Failure to follow the code of practice may result in an exhibitor being asked to leave the show.
